O. 1150 (I)/2015.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (i), (j), (k), (l), (m) and (n) of section 23 of the Pakistan Veterinary Medical Council Act, 1996 (III of 1996), the Pakistan Veterinary Medical Council, with the previous sanction of the Federal Government, is pleased to direct that the following amendments shall be made in the Pakistan Veterinary Medical Council - Standards of Education Regulations, 2001, namely:—

In the aforesaid Regulations, for regulation 4, the following shall be substituted, namely:—

4. **Admission to DVM Degree Programme.**—No candidate shall be admitted to Doctor of Veterinary Medicine (DVM) programme unless he has passed,

- (a) FSc (Pre-Medical) examination from a recognized board of Education in Pakistan; or
- (b) an examination considered equivalent to the Intermediate (Pre-Medical) or HSSC (Pre-medical) examination by the Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC); or
- (c) in case of students from foreign countries:
 - (i) a certificate of having passed Intermediate Examination (Pre-Medical) with Physics, Chemistry (Including Organic Chemistry) Biology and English as subject of the examination; and
 - (ii) the candidate must have passed IELTS, TOEFL or a similar examination so as to confirm that he can read, write and speak English fluently enough to be able to benefit from the theoretical and practical classes.”
